**ORDINANCE**

**APPROVING CONTRACT AMENDMENTS AND THE ALLOCATION OF UNSPENT  
EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT FUNDING BY THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF,  
AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (ESG-CV) IN THE AMOUNTS OF \$339,309 TO  
CORAZON MINISTRIES FOR HOMELESS STREET OUTREACH AND \$100,000 FOR  
CATHOLIC CHARITIES FOR HOMELESS PREVENTION FOR A PERIOD ENDING  
SEPTEMBER 30, 2023.**

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**WHEREAS**, in 2020 the City of San Antonio received \$16,853,222 in Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act); and

**WHEREAS**, the funding (referred to as ESG-CV) was allocated to cities and other local governments to assist in preventing, preparing for, and responding to the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on people experiencing or at risk of homelessness; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of the City's COVID-19 Recovery and Resiliency plan, the Department of Human Services (DHS) allocated ESG-CV funds in the amounts of \$815,692 for homeless prevention and \$2,745,012 for street outreach; and

**WHEREAS**, homeless prevention activities include rental assistance with case management to prevent at-risk households from experiencing homelessness, entering emergency shelters, or sleeping on the streets; and

**WHEREAS**, street outreach activities include direct services to individuals experiencing unsheltered homelessness to connect them with housing and shelter options; and

**WHEREAS**, in April 2022, HUD approved an extension for communities to spend ESG-CV dollars through September 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, DHS has identified \$439,309 in ESG-CV funds that will not be spent as initially allocated; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance would allocate those funds, through a contract amendment, to eligible activities to ensure the funds are spent by the appropriate deadline; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Department of Human Services (DHS) or designee, is hereby authorized to execute amendments to contracts with Corazon Ministries for homeless street outreach in the amount of \$339,309.00 and \$100,000.00 to Catholic Charities for homeless prevention for a period ending September 30, 2023.

**SECTION 2.** Fund 2103800001 Internal Order 13800002936 and GL 5202040 are hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in execution of a contract amendment in substantially the same form as shown in Attachment I for a total amount of \$100,000.00, and to incorporate as attachments to the amendment, an amended scope of work, performance measures or budget. Payment not to exceed \$100,000.00 is authorized to Catholic Charities upon issuance of a purchase order.

**SECTION 3.** Fund 2103800001 Internal Order 13800002942 and GL 5202040 are hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in execution of a contract amendment in substantially the same form as shown in Attachment II for a total amount of \$339,309.00, and to incorporate as attachments to the amendment, an amended scope of work, performance measures or budget. Payment not to exceed \$339,390.00 is authorized to Corazon Ministries upon issuance of a purchase order.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
