

ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONCESSIONS AGREEMENT WITH JACOBSEN/DANIELS ASSOCIATES, LLC DBA FLY-AWAY VALET TO UPDATE CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE AGREEMENT CONCERNING ADJUSTMENTS TO THE LEASE PREMISES AND APPLICABLE PERCENTAGE FEES FOR THEIR OPERATIONS AT THE SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

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WHEREAS, City Council authorized a five-year concessions agreement with Fly-Away Valet on December 6, 2018 to operate curbside valet services for the San Antonio International Airport; and

WHEREAS, Fly-Away Valet and the City wish to update certain provisions of the concessions agreement that will affect the percentage rent and leased premises; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes an amendment to the concessions agreement with Jacobsen/Daniels Associates, LLC dba Fly-Away Valet to update certain provisions of the agreement concerning adjustments to the lease premises and applicable percentage fees for their operations at the San Antonio International Airport, with the minimum annual guarantee remaining in the amount of \$200,000.00 with a 10% commission on the cost for all value-added services and customer amenities;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute an amendment to the concessions agreement with Jacobsen/Daniels Associates, LLC dba Fly-Away Valet to update certain provisions of the agreement concerning adjustments to the lease premises and applicable percentage fees for their operations at the San Antonio International Airport, attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

SECTION 2. Funds received for this ordinance will be deposited in Fund 51001000, Internal Order 233000000169 and General Ledger 4409034.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
