ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS FROM THE TEXAS HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMISSION (HHSC) FOR THE WOMEN, INFANTS AND CHILDREN (WIC) LOCAL AGENCY GRANT CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,443,304.00 FOR A TOTAL GRANT AMOUNT OF \$7,585,526.00 FOR A PERIOD STARTING OCTOBER 1, 2022 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2023.

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WHEREAS, on January 27, 2022, City Council authorized approval of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's (Metro Health) annual state and federal pass-through grant awards for FY 2023, through ordinance 2022-01-27-0042; and

WHEREAS, Metro Health anticipated receiving funds in the amount of \$6,107,243.00 for the WIC Local Agency grant contract; and

WHEREAS, thereafter, Metro Health received a revised award on January 24, 2023, in the amount of \$7,585,526.00, equating to an additional \$1,443,304.00 for the grant period ending September 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program is designed to serve pregnant and post-partum women, infants and children who are at nutritional risk and have an income at or below the 185% of the Federal Poverty Level or have been determined to be automatically income-eligible based on participation in certain programs; and

WHEREAS, funds will support Metro Health's WIC program to continue to provide services and to safeguard the health of low-income women, infants and children who are at a nutrition risk;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or designee, is hereby authorized to accept additional funds in the amount of \$1,443,304.00 for a total grant award of \$7,585,526.00 from the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) for the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Local Agency Grant contract for a period starting October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or designee, is further authorized to initiate, negotiate, and execute any and all necessary documents and a grant contract to effectuate the acceptance of the grant referenced in

Section 1 of this ordinance and to execute contract amendments pertaining to this contract to include a) carry-over funds, when ascertained and approved by the funding agency through a revised notice of award; b) line item budget revisions authorized by the funding agency; c) modifications to the performance measures authorized by the funding agency and listed in the contract so long as the terms of the amendment stay within the general parameters of the intent of the grant; d) no cost extensions; e) amendments which will provide supplemental grant funds to the grant by the funding agency in an amount up to 20% of the total amount awarded to the grant; f) reimbursement increases of administrative funds for each participant served; g) amendments funding one time equipment purchases or defined program services; and h) changes in regulations mandated by the funding agency.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, new funds and internal order numbers will be created, upon which the award amount will be appropriated from the HHSC. A final budget, which will include SAP Internal Orders and SAP GL Accounts, will be submitted by the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District upon award. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
