**APPOINTING _____ AS THE TEMPORARY CITY COUNCIL
MEMBER FOR DISTRICT 7.**

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2023, Councilmember Ana Sandoval announced her resignation from office to assume new employment beginning January 30, 2023, creating a vacancy in the office; and

WHEREAS, the City Council invited qualified residents of District 7 to submit applications to the Office of the City Clerk as provided by Section 2-36 of the City Code to fill the office for the remainder of the unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, on Wednesday, March 1, 2023, applicants provided comments, both written and oral, to the City Council on their qualifications and interest in serving during this time; and

WHEREAS, applicants were selected for interviews at the A Session on March 2, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to appoint a Councilmember for the District 7 City Council office for the remainder of the unexpired term; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. _____ is appointed to serve as the District 7 member of the City Council of the City of San Antonio, to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is effective immediately.
