ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH AIRBUS HELICOPTERS, INC. TO PROVIDE RECURRENT AND TRANSITION PILOT AND CREW FLIGHT TRAINING EFFECTIVE MAY 11, 2023 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2023 IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$187,459.00.

WHEREAS, the City entered into an agreement with Airbus Helicopters, Inc. to provide recurrent and transition pilot and crew flight training; and

WHEREAS, City staff now recommends the flight training be continued with Airbus Helicopters, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Airbus Helicopters, Inc. provides training specific to this model helicopter; and

WHEREAS, this training is required to meet FAA recurrent training mandates; and

WHEREAS, said agreement provides for a term beginning May 11, 2023 through December 31, 2023; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to execute a Professional Services Contract with Airbus Helicopters, Inc. for a period beginning May 11, 2023 to December 31, 2023. A copy of the Professional Services Agreement is attached as Exhibit 1.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of 150,555.00 for this ordinance is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 1704050001 and General Ledger 5201040 as part of the Fiscal Year 2023 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Additional funding is contingent upon City Council approval of the Fiscal Year 2024 and subsequent budgets that fall within the contract terms of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Payment is authorized to Airbus Helicopter, Inc. (Airbus) and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

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SECTION 6. This Ordinance becomes effective immediately if passed and approved by eight (8) affirmative votes; otherwise this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days from the date of passage.
