

ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF ADDITIONAL GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA) AIRPORT TERMINAL PROGRAM (ATP) UNDER THE BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW (BIL), IF AWARDED, FOR THE TERMINAL A GROUND LOADING FACILITY PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$24,400,000 AND AMENDS THE FY 2023 - FY 2028 CAPITAL BUDGET.

WHEREAS, On November 15, 2021, President Biden signed the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), commonly referred to as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), which included funds for the FAA Airport Infrastructure Grants (AIG) program and Airport Terminal Program (ATP); and

WHEREAS, in May 2023 the City approved a design-build contract with Hensel Phelps Construction Co. for the construction of the Terminal A Ground Load Facility and accepted and appropriated an FAA ATP program grant award in the amount of \$20,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, because the FAA in June indicated that there may be additional grant funding available for the Terminal A Ground Load Facility project, this ordinance further accepts and appropriates additional grant funds and approves the execution of any related grant documents in the not to exceed amount of \$24,000,000 million for that project, if offered; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance will authorize acceptance and appropriation of additional funds in the not to exceed amount of \$24,400,000 million for the Terminal A Ground Load Facility and amend the FY 2023 - FY 2028 Capital Budget, if awarded; **NOW THEREFORE;**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of Airports or designee, is hereby authorized to accept additional grant funds from the FAA ATP Program for the for the Terminal A Ground Load Facility project at San Antonio International Airport in an amount not to exceed \$24,400,000 , if awarded, for a total potential grant award of \$44,400,000.00. This action will amend the FY2023 – FY2028 Capital Improvement Program.

SECTION 2. Upon award, a new fund and internal order will be created, upon which the sum of up to \$24.400.000.00 from the FAA will be appropriated in said fund. A formal budget will also be provided once funds are awarded.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance and appropriation of the award, the amount of \$24,400,000.00 shall be transferred from the new grant fund to Fund 51099000 Airport Capital Projects, Project 33-00340 Terminal A Ground Loading Facility.

SECTION 4. The budget in Project 33-00340 shall be revised by increasing WBS 33-00340-90-XX-XX with GL 6101100 and WBS 33-00340-05-02-01 with GL 5201140 each by \$24,400,000.00.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
