**ORDINANCE**

**AMENDING CHAPTER 19 OF THE CITY CODE TO UPDATE  
TRAFFIC CONTROL SCHEDULES OF DEVICES, ADDING 56  
LOCATIONS CITYWIDE WHERE NEW INSTALLATIONS OF  
TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES HAVE OCCURRED, AND  
REMOVING 8 LOCATIONS CITYWIDE WHERE DEVICES HAVE  
BEEN ALTERED OR REMOVED.**

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance will update various Traffic Control Schedules of Devices established in Chapter 19, Section 68(b) of the City Code of Ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, traffic control devices include, but are not limited to, stop signs, traffic signals, parking restrictions, and speed limit designations; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance will enable consistent enforcement of on-street traffic regulations and will further City Council's policy to maintain an efficient and safe flow of traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, updated traffic control schedules will reflect new installations of traffic control devices and/or the removal of such devices at specified locations; and

**WHEREAS**, December 15, 2022 marked the latest update to the Traffic Control Schedules of Devices; and

**WHEREAS**, the following traffic control devices were added (included) since the previously enacted traffic code update on December 15, 2022.

1. All Way Stops –  
(2 additional locations) [Schedule C(a) – update]
2. Cross Street Stop –  
(19 additional locations) [Schedule C(b) - update]
3. Maximum Speed Limit –  
(3 additional location) [Schedule E(a) – update]
4. Parking Prohibited at All Times, Including Sundays, and Holidays –  
(27 additional locations) [Schedule G(a) - update]
5. Stopping, Standing or Parking Prohibited Seven AM to Nine AM and Two PM to Four PM

School Days Only –  
(2 additional location) [Schedule H(i) - update]

6. School Speed Zones, School Crosswalks (Intersection), Seven AM to Nine AM and Two PM to Four PM, 20 mph, School Days Only, Cell Phone Use Prohibited –  
(1 additional location) [Schedule M(b) – update]

7. Commercial Loading Zone, 30-Minute Limit –  
(1 additional location) [Schedule P(a) – update]

8. Student Loading Zone, Seven AM to Nine AM and Two PM to Four PM School Days Only –  
(1 additional location) [Schedule P(l) – update]

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance amends the Traffic Control Schedules of Devices established in Chapter 19, Section 68(b) of the City Code to add 56 locations of new installations of traffic control devices and to remove 8 locations where devices have been altered or removed; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Public Works Department or designee, is authorized to amend the Traffic Control Schedules of Devices established in Chapter 19, Section 68(b) of the City Code to add 56 locations of new installations of traffic control devices and to remove 8 locations where devices have been altered or removed.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
