**ORDINANCE**

**APPROVING AN AMENDMENT IN THE INCREASED AMOUNT  
NOT TO EXCEED \$366,211.00 FOR A REVISED INTERLOCAL  
AGREEMENT VALUE OF \$23,649,838.71 WITH THE SAN  
ANTONIO RIVER AUTHORITY, OF WHICH \$366,211.00 WILL BE  
REIMBURSED BY THE CITY TO SARA FOR CONSTRUCTION  
COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE COMPLETION OF  
ADDITIONAL ROADWAY, SIDEWALK, TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND  
IRRIGATION EQUIPMENT, PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS  
RELATED TO THE CAMARON STREET (WEST HOUSTON  
STREET TO FOX TECH HIGH SCHOOL) PROJECT  
CONSTRUCTED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE SAN PEDRO  
CREEK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT LOCATED IN COUNCIL  
DISTRICT 1. FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE FROM 2017 GENERAL  
OBLIGATION BOND FUNDS INCLUDED IN THE FY 2023 – FY 2028  
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, on May 6, 2017, voters approved the 2017 Bond Program, which included funds in the amount of \$4,500,000.00 to develop pedestrian corridor improvements on Camaron and Kingsbury from West Houston to Flores Street near Fox Tech High School. Additionally, the Bond Program includes \$14,600,000 under Proposition 2 (Drainage & Flood Control Improvements) and \$4,900,000.00 under Proposition 3 (Parks, Recreation & Open Space Improvements) for a total of \$19,500,000.00 to support improvements associated with drainage components of Phase 1 and 2 of the San Pedro Creek Improvements Project; and

**WHEREAS**, On December 14, 2017, City Council approved an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the City and SARA through Ordinance 2017-12-14-0995 in the amount of \$19,500,000.00 with Sundt-Davila for the construction of Phases 1 and 2 of the San Pedro Creek Improvements Project. Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Agreement approved by Council through Ordinance 2019-01-17-0022 allocated \$3,150,000.00 to the Camaron Street (West Houston Street to Fox Tech High) Project (“Project”) for design and construction improvements. Amendment No. 1 included the Camaron Street Project within the existing San Pedro Creek Project; and

**WHEREAS**, Amendment No. 2 to the ILA approved by Council through Ordinance 2017-12-14-0995 allocated \$250,000.00 for the demolition and repairs of the west courtyard wall of the Spanish Governor’s Palace. Amendment No. 2 reimbursed SARA for the design and construction of the wall; and

**WHEREAS**, Amendment No. 3 to the ILA approved by Council through Ordinance 2022-04-14-0264 allocated \$383,627.71 for additional construction services on the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed amendment will increase the contract capacity by a total of \$366,211.00 to a revised contract value of \$23,649,838.71.

The following table illustrates the previously authorized amendments since the execution of this agreement:

The proposed Amendment No. 4 will reimburse SARA for the additional construction necessary to complete the street and pedestrian improvements related to the Camaron Street (West Houston Street to Fox Tech High School) Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Camaron Street pedestrian corridor and roadway construction began in June 2021 and was completed in Spring 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance approves an amendment in the increased amount not to exceed \$366,211.00 for a revised Interlocal Agreement value of \$23,649,838.71 with the San Antonio River Authority, of which \$366,211.00 will be reimbursed by the City to SARA for construction costs associated with the completion of additional roadway, sidewalk, traffic signal and irrigation equipment, permits and inspections related to the Camaron Street (West Houston Street to Fox Tech High School) project constructed in conjunction with the San Pedro Creek Improvements project located in Council District 1. Funds are available from 2017 General Obligation Bond funds included in the FY 2023 – FY 2028 Capital Improvement Program; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute an amendment in the increased amount not to exceed \$366,211.00 for a revised Interlocal Agreement value of \$23,649,838.71 with the San Antonio River Authority, for construction costs associated with Camaron Street (West Houston Street to Fox Tech High School) Project.

**SECTION 2.** The increased payment amount is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to San Antonio River Authority (SARA) in an amount not to exceed \$366,211.00. Payment is in support of the Camaron Street (W. Houston St. to Fox Tech High) Project using WBS 23-01567-05-02-01 with GL 5201140. Funding for this project is provided by General Obligation Bonds and is in the FY 2023 – FY 2028 Capital Improvement Program Budget.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
