ORDINANCE

APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF ALAMO HEIGHTS TO ACCEPT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$116,000.00 FOR SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ON N. NEW BRAUNFELS AVENUE BETWEEN CASTANO AVENUE AND CLAYWELL DRIVE, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 10; AND THE AMENDING OF THE FY 2023 – FY 2028 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM WITH THE APPROPRIATION OF THESE FUNDS FROM THE CITY OF ALAMO HEIGHTS TO THE ADVANCED TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT FY 2023 SIDEWALKS PROJECT FOR SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ON N. NEW BRAUNFELS AVENUE.

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WHEREAS, New Braunfels Avenue is the boundary between the City of Alamo Heights and the City of San Antonio from Austin Highway to Claywell Drive. The City of San Antonio maintains the right-of-way for this approximately 1.2 miles. Pedestrian accessibility is currently limited to the eastern side of N. New Braunfels, which is the only side of the street with sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alamo Heights and the City of San Antonio desire to add 0.4 miles of sidewalk and curb improvements on the western side of N. New Braunfels between Castano Avenue and Claywell Drive, extending pedestrian access between Alamo Heights Junior School and Castano Avenue to Alamo Heights High School; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated N. New Braunfels Avenue project cost is \$232,000.00. This Interlocal Agreement allows the City to accept funds in the amount of \$116,000.00 from the City of Alamo Heights for their share of construction costs for sidewalk improvements associated with this project. The City of San Antonio’s Public Works Department will oversee all construction management and engineering for the project. The City’s share of the costs is \$116,000.00 and funding is available from FY 2023 Advanced Transportation District Fund and the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alamo Heights approved the proposed Interlocal Agreement at their city council meeting on March 27, 2023, authorizing their share of the project cost in the amount of \$116,000.00; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves Interlocal Agreement with the City of Alamo Heights to accept funds in the amount of \$116,000.00 for sidewalk improvements on N. New Braunfels Avenue between Castano Avenue and Claywell Drive, located in Council District 10; and the amending of the FY 2023 – FY 2028 Capital Improvement Program with the appropriation of these

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funds from the City of Alamo Heights to the ATD FY 2023 Sidewalks project for sidewalk improvements on N. New Braunfels Avenue; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement, which is attached to and incorporated in this document as **Exhibit A**, between the City of San Antonio and the City of Alamo Heights, thereby accepting funds from the City of Alamo Heights in an amount not to exceed \$116,000.00 for sidewalk improvements on N. New Braunfels Avenue.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$116,000.00 is authorized to be received from the City of Alamo Heights and shall be appropriated in SAP Fund 40099000, WBS 23-04071-90-10-01 with GL 6101100.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$116,000.00 shall be appropriated in SAP Fund 40099000, WBS 23-04071-05-02-08 with GL 5201245.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
