

RFCA #23-192304

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or designee, is authorized to accept an agreement with San Antonio Area Foundation (SAAF) for administration and distribution of funding to community organizations for developing strategies to implement initiatives that address food insecurity, housing stability, and access to health care for the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's Policy and Civic Engagement Office in the amount of \$400,000.00 for the period beginning July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024, with the option to renew for one one-year term, for a total up to \$800,000.00.

SECTION 2. Funding is available from Internal Order Number 136000001855, General Ledger 5202020, and Fund 2103600024 entitled "PH Infrastructure", for a total amount up to \$800,000.00. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to SAAF upon issuance of a purchase order.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
