

RFCA #23-192400

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Office of Sustainability or designee is hereby authorized to apply for and accept grant funds upon award in the amount up to \$20,000,000.00 from the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Grant to design and construct a complete street corridor between Malone Avenue and Culberson Avenue, and authorizing a Resiliency, Energy, Efficiency, and Sustainability (REES) Fund contribution of 20% or \$4,000,000.00 for the period October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Office of Sustainability or designee, or the Director of Public Works or designee, or the Director of Parks and Recreation or designee is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 2. Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the award amount up to \$20,000,000.00 will be appropriated from the USDOT, is hereby authorized. The proposed budget, including a REES Fund cash matching contribution of 20% or \$4,000,000.00 is approved and attached hereto as **Attachment I**. A formal budget will be submitted by the department upon receipt.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
