This was my motivation to get involved on the 2022-2027 Bond Committee. While it is true that the 2022 bond will fund a complete reconstruction of much of this road, I want to continue to serve and advocate for an equity lens to be applied as projects are prioritized and unfortunately scaled back due to cost overruns. This equity lens is necessary so that historically underserved neighborhoods will become safer places to live.</p>
