ORDINANCE

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH LMR HOG TRAPPERS, LLC, TO PROVIDE FERAL HOG REMOVAL SERVICES, INCLUDING SETTING UP, MAINTAINING, MOVING, AND TAKING DOWN FERAL HOG TRAPS, AT VARIOUS SITES WITHIN THE SAN ANTONIO CITY LIMITS, BEGINNING UPON AWARD AND ENDING MARCH 31, 2026, WITH TWO, ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS, FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$35,000.00, AND AN ESTIMATED TOTAL COST OF \$175,000.00 FOR THE ENTIRE CONTRACT PERIOD INCLUDING RENEWAL OPTIONS. FUNDING IS FROM THE FY 2023 ADOPTED GENERAL FUND BUDGET. FUNDING FOR SUBSEQUENT YEARS IS CONTINGENT UPON CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL OF THE ANNUAL BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, the City released a Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP) to provide the City of San Antonio with feral hog removal services, including setting up, maintaining, moving, and taking down feral hog traps, at various sites within the San Antonio city limits; and

WHEREAS, feral hogs have caused damage to City property, pose a health and safety concern to the community, and require professional hog trapping services to provide a humane and effective way to dramatically reduce local populations of feral pigs and address the environmental and safety issues associated with a growing feral hog population; and

WHEREAS, three proposals were received and evaluated; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends LMR Hog Trappers, LLC, for award of a contract based on the City's standard RFCSP evaluation process; and

WHEREAS, approval of this ordinance will authorize a contract beginning upon award and ending March 31, 2026, with the option for the City to renew for two additional, one-year periods, for an estimated annual cost of \$35,000.00, and an estimated total cost of \$175,000.00 for the entire contract period including renewal options; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The proposal submitted by LMR Hog Trappers, LLC, to provide the City of San Antonio with feral hog removal services, including setting up, maintaining, moving, and taking down feral hog traps, at various sites within the San Antonio city limits for an estimated annual cost of \$35,000.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the Score Summary and RFCSP is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to LMR Hog Trappers, LLC, for an estimated annual cost of \$35,000.00. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2023 budget and subsequent budgets for the duration of this contract as approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
