AN ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF LINE-OF-DUTY
INJURY LEAVE FOR SAN ANTONIO FIRE
DEPARTMENT FIREFIGHTER EDWARD CHACON.**

WHEREAS, section 143.073 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that a firefighter injured in the line of duty is entitled to line-of-duty injury leave with full pay for a period commensurate with the injury and not to exceed one year; and

WHEREAS, section 143.073 also provides that a municipality's governing body may extend the line-of-duty injury leave beyond one year; and

WHEREAS, San Antonio Fire Department Firefighter, Edward Chacon, was injured in the line of duty on December 3, 2016, and, as a result, required leave in excess of one year to address said injury; and

WHEREAS, Firefighter Chacon is requesting an extension of line-of-duty injury leave beyond one year for the period January 24, 2018, to September 2, 2021 where leave was intermittently used; and

WHEREAS, approving the requested extension will restore 2,718 hours of accrued leave to Firefighter Chacon; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. An extension beyond one year of San Antonio Fire Department Firefighter Chacon's line-of-duty injury leave for the intermittent period used between January 24, 2018, to September 2, 2021, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
