

ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT OF MOTOF VEHICLE ACCIDENT CLAIM ON BEHALF OF DIANA GALVAN IN A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$61,828.65.

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WHEREAS, an auto accident occurred on January 13, 2023 on S Zarzarmora & West Mayfield, involving a City owned vehicle operated by an employee of the San Antonio Police Department and a vehicle driven by Plaintiff Diana Galvan; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this accident, Diana Galvan alleges her 2022 Cadillac Escalade was totaled; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio has accepted liability in this matter.

WHEREAS, the parties have reached an agreement to settle the claims of Diana Galvan in the amount of \$61,828.65 payable from the Self-Insurance Liability Fund subject to City Council approval; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$61,828.65 is authorized to be paid from Fund 75001000, Insurance Reserve Fund, General Ledger 5402530 General Liability Claims, Cost Center 7509020001 Risk Management-Liability, and is authorized to be made payable as follows: \$61,828.65 will be paid to Kemper Insurance Company in settlement of the Property Damage claim.

SECTION 2. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
