ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT UP
TO \$1,354,711.00 FROM THE MOTOR VEHICLE CRIME PREVENTION
AUTHORITY FOR THE REGIONAL AUTO CRIMES TEAM GRANT
FOR THE PRIOD OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2023 TO AUGUST 31, 2024.**

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WHEREAS, the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority (MVCPA) has grant funds available to fund the Regional Auto Crimes Team (ReACT), in an amount up to \$1,354,711.00; and

WHEREAS, the grant would be used to provide funding for fifteen positions, twelve with the San Antonio Police Department, and one investigator each with the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS), the Guadalupe County Sheriff's Office (GCSO) and the National Insurance Crime Bureau (NICB), to reduce automobile burglary and theft offenses; and

WHEREAS, the grant is for the period from September 1, 2023, to August 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, a cash match of \$479,036.00 is required from the City's General Fund and \$97,271 from NICB. In addition, an in-kind match of \$2,679,711.00 is required from the City, and \$134,248.00 from DPS; and

WHEREAS, award of the grant will necessitate the execution of agreements with DPS, GCSO and NICB; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Chief of Police or designee are hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount up to \$1,354,711.00 from the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority (MVCPA), with an in-kind match of \$2,679,711.00, in which \$134,248.00 will be from the Texas Department of Public Safety, a cash match not to exceed \$479,036.00, in which \$97,271.00 will be from National Insurance Crime Bureau as salary in lieu of cash match, and program income of \$30,000.00 for the Regional Auto Crimes Team (ReACT) Program for the grant period September 1, 2023 through August 31, 2024. A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Police Department.

SECTION 2: The City Manager and designee, and the Chief of Police and designee, are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said acceptance.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order numbers will be created, upon which the award amount not to exceed \$1,354,711.00 from the MVCPA will be

appropriated in said fund. A final budget, including a department specific fund, an Internal Order number, and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit A**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books.

SECTION 4. City cash match not to exceed \$479,036.00 is contingent upon the approval of the fiscal year 2024 General Fund Budget.

SECTION 5. The attached proposed personnel complement of twelve positions, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit B**, is approved.

SECTION 6. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
