ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE SAN ANTONIO OFFICE OF EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE UPON AWARD UP
TO \$1,217,391.30 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
AGENCY'S 2021 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT AND
AUTHORIZING A CASH MATCH OF \$182,608.70.**

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WHEREAS, there are grant funds in an amount up to \$1,217,321.30 available from the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the 2021 AFGP is to enhance the safety of the public and firefighters with respect to fire and fire-related hazards; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2021 the city applied for these funds and on April 17, 2023 the city received an award letter for funding for a platform ladder truck;

WHEREAS, this grant requires a cash match of \$182,608.70; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the City of San Antonio Emergency Management or designee, is hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount up to \$1,217,391.30 from FEMA for the 2021 AFG. This ordinance also authorizes a cash match up to \$182,608.70 from the General Fund. Funding is available from the General Fund FY 2023 Adopted Budget. A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Office of Emergency Management.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the City of San Antonio Emergency Management or designee, is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the sum not to exceed \$1,217,391.30 will be appropriated from FEMA. A formal final budget will be submitted by the department upon receipt.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
