STEP Grant funds have been awarded to SAPD annually for over 20 years

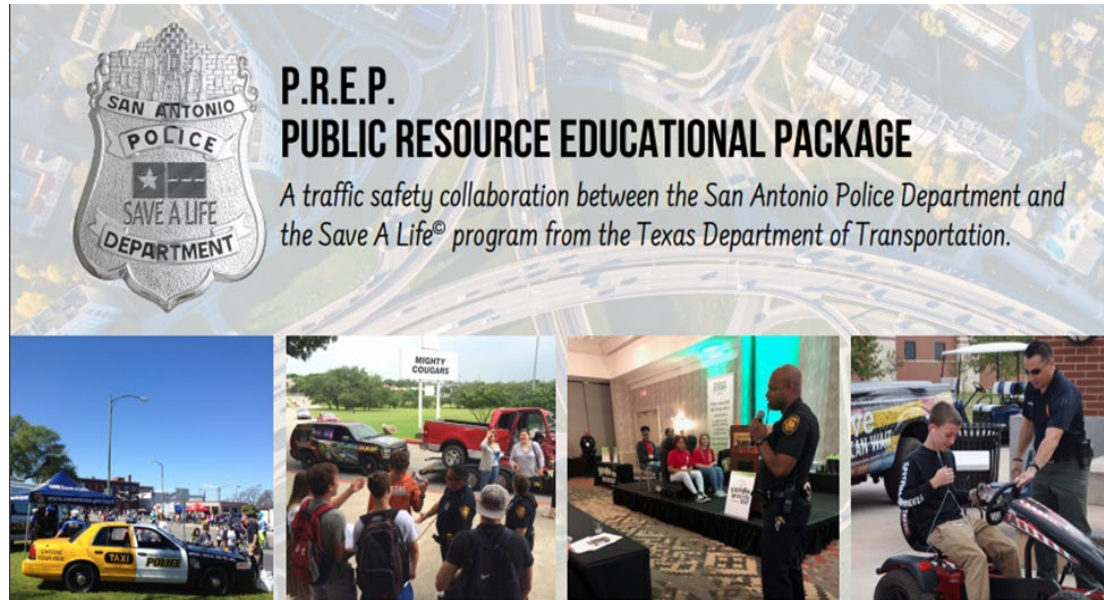

Grant Award

Grant Period: October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024

- Grant funds - \$843,000
- Cash match - \$265,000
- In-kind match - \$82,000
