Under my leadership at SARA, the Bexar Regional Watershed Management Program was created to promote collaboration among governmental entities addressing and investing in watershed management tools

(such as flood maps, models) and in capital projects. The BRWM became the model for the State Flood Planning Process. I am a strong advocate for the use of nature based solutions, where appropriate, to reduce the impact of impervious cover as the city grows, and protecting the habitat and function and health of our rivers and creeks. Serving on this advisory board will enable me to continue to offer my experience and expertise to ensure coordinated, watershed based decisions related to flood and stormwater management.
