**ORDINANCE**

**APPOINTING LARISSA MARTINEZ (DISTRICT 6) TO THE MAYOR'S  
COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN FOR THE REMAINDER  
OF AN UNEXPIRED TERM OF OFFICE TO EXPIRE MAY 31, 2025; AND  
WAIVING THE CITY CODE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT IN  
CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE IX, SECTION 2-259(B), FOR THIS  
APPOINTMENT.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Larissa Martinez (District 6) is appointed to the Mayor's Commission on the Status of Women for the remainder of an unexpired term of office to expire May 31, 2025.

**SECTION 2.** The residency requirement of Section 2-259(b) of Chapter 2, Article IX, is waived for this appointment.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes, otherwise, it is effective ten days after appointment.
