

RFCA #23-193324

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the San Antonio Chief of Police or designee, is hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$843,000.00 for the Comprehensive Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Grant from the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and authorizes an in-kind match up to \$82,000.00, which will be fulfilled by the cost of fuel, maintenance, and repairs of the vehicles used while performing grant activities, and the cost of court appearances by officers who make arrests while performing grant activities, and approves a required cash match of \$265,000.00 from the General Fund contingent upon the available funding the fiscal year 2024 budget for the period of October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024. A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Police Department.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee, or the San Antonio Chief of Police or designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 3. Upon award, a new fund and internal order will be created for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant and the amounts listed above totaling a sum not to exceed \$843,000.00 will be appropriated in said funds. A formal final budget which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
