- **SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Office of Sustainability or designee is hereby authorized to apply for and accept grant funds upon award in the amount up to \$30,000,000.00 from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) to participate in the Texas Solar for All Coalition's application to the Solar for All grant competition to expand the number of low-income and disadvantaged communities primed for residential solar investment for a period beginning September 2023 through August 2028. There is no impact to the City's General Fund in the form of a cash match.
- **SECTION 2.** The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Office of Sustainability or designee is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance.
- **SECTION 3.** Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the award amount up to \$30,000,000.00 will be appropriated from the US EPA, is hereby authorized. A formal budget will be submitted by the department upon receipt.
- **SECTION 4.** The personnel complement of one (1) position, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment VI** is hereby approved.
- **SECTION 5.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.
- **SECTION 6.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
