

RFCA #23-194242

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Chief of Police for the City of San Antonio or designee, is hereby authorized to accept grant funds, upon award, in an amount up to \$397,684.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) in support of the Child Welfare Strategic Alliance Program for the 2023 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) for a grant period beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2026.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee, or the Chief of Police for the City of San Antonio or designee, is hereby authorized to execute an interlocal agreement with Bexar County that authorizes Bexar County to submit a 2023 Justice Assistance Grant application to the DOJ in support of the Child Welfare Strategic Alliance Program, that designates Bexar County as the grant's fiscal agent, and that provides that Bexar County will conduct the administration of the grant funds. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto as **Attachment I**, and the terms of the agreement are hereby approved. Should the parties be unable to agree upon an agreement that is substantially the same as attached, subsequent City Council action shall be required for authorization to execute the agreement.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order numbers will be created, upon which the sum of up to \$397,684.00 from the DOJ will be appropriated in said fund. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books. The proposed personnel complement of two (2) positions, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
