Solicitation Overview

The Information Technology Services Department solicited a contractor to provide security officer services for buildings, facilities, grounds, and rights-of-ways, for employees, and visitors; emergency response, access control, technology control station monitoring, mobile patrol, and other related security services. It is estimated that the City will utilize these services for approximately 335,000 hours annually for security officer services for emergency response, access control, technology control station monitoring, mobile/foot patrol and other related security services.
