ORDINANCE

APPROVING CONTRACTS WITH H&E EQUIPMENT SERVICES, INC., ASSOCIATED SUPPLY COMPANY, INC., DBA ASCO EQUIPMENT CO., TEXAS STATE RENTAL, HOLT TEXAS LTD, DBA HOLT CAT, TO PROVIDE THE PUBLIC WORKS, SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT, PARKS AND RECREATION, AND BUILDING AND EQUIPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENTS WITH 36 OFF ROAD EQUIPMENT UNITS FOR AN ESTIMATED TOTAL COST OF \$3,017,258.51. FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$145,199.70 IS AVAILABLE FROM THE FY 2022 FLEET SERVICES FUND BUDGET AND \$2,872,058.81 IS AVAILABLE FROM THE FY 2022 EQUIPMENT RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT FUND BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City with off road equipment needed for road maintenance, movement of raw materials and supply management; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Clark Equipment Company for item 1 failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for off road equipment; and

WHEREAS, H&E Equipment Services, Inc., submitted the low responsive bid for items 1 and 19 for a total cost of \$291,040.00; Associated Supply Company, Inc., dba ASCO Equipment Co., submitted the low bid for items 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 9 10, 15, 17, 18, for a total cost of \$1,128,721.70; Texas State Rental submitted the low bid for items 4, 6 and 11 for a total cost of \$856,394.81 and Holt Texas LTD, dba Holt Cat, submitted the low bid for items 12 and 14 for a total cost of \$741,102.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bids submitted by H&E Equipment Services, Inc., (Items 1 and 19); Associated Supply Company, Inc., dba ASCO Equipment Co., (Items 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 9 10, 15, 17, and 18); Texas State Rental (Items 4, 6 and 11); and Holt Texas LTD, dba Holt Cat, (Items 12 and 14), to provide the City with an estimated 36 off road equipment units for an estimated total cost of \$3,017,258.51 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I.**

SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the bid submitted by Clark Equipment Company for item 1 failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for off road equipment.

SECTION 3. Funding for this ordinance in the total amount of \$3,017,258.51 is available in the following Funds, Cost Centers, and General Ledgers as part of the Fiscal Year 2022 Adopted Budget approved by City Council:

SECTION 4. Payment is authorized in the amount up to \$1,128,721.70 to Associated Supply Company, Inc., dba ASCO Equipment Co., in the amount up to \$291,040.00 to H&E Equipment Services, Inc., in the amount up to \$741,102.00 to Holt Texas LTD, dba Holt Cat, and in the amount up to \$856,394.81 to Texas State Rental, and should be encumbered with purchase orders.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
