ORDINANCE

**APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH HUB PARKING
TECHNOLOGY USA, INC., TO PROVIDE 27 ENTRY AND
EXIT LANE STATIONS FOR THE AVIATION
DEPARTMENT, PARKING DIVISION FOR A TOTAL
COST OF \$237,809.79. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE FROM
THE FY 2022 AIRPORT OPERATING AND
MAINTENANCE FUND BUDGET.**

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WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by HUB Parking Technology USA, Inc., to provide the City with 27 entry and exit lane stations for the Aviation Department, Parking Division for a total cost of \$237,809.79; and

WHEREAS, the new entry and exit lane stations will enable Airport customers to pay for parking without touching any hardware or screen surfaces; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(7)(A), which provides for any items that are available only from a sole source of supply; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from HUB Parking Technology USA, Inc., to provide the City with 27 entry and exit lane stations for the Aviation Department, Parking Division for a total cost of \$237,809.79 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$237,809.79 is available in Fund 51001000, Cost Center 3305040006 and General Ledger 5203080 as part of the Fiscal Year 2022 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Payment is authorized to HUB Parking Technology USA, Inc., and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
