ELIGIBILITY



The HDRC found 326 Seguin St eligible under the following criteria: UDC Sec. 35-607(b)

- 3. Its identification with a person or persons who significantly contributed to the development of the community, county, state, or nation;
- 5. Its embodiment of distinguishing characteristics of an architectural style valuable for the study of a period, type, method of construction, or use of indigenous materials;
- 6. Its historical, architectural or cultural character as a particularly fine or unique example of a utilitarian structure, including, but not limited to, bridges, acequias, gas stations, transportation shelters, or other commercial structures;
- 8: Its historical, architectural, or cultural integrity of location, design, materials, and workmanship;
- 12: It is an important example of a particular architectural type or specimen.



CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION

The City Council finds the property eligible for landmark designation and directs City staff to initiate zoning changes for and designation of 326 Seguin.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff did not find that the property meets the threshold for designation. The Historic and Design Review Commission may recommend approval of historic landmark designation of 326 Seguin.
