SUBJECT: Consideration of Completed High Profile Solicitation

DATE: August 20, 2021

The following high-profile project has completed the solicitation process. This item is presented to the Audit and Accountability Committee for review prior to the full City Council for consideration.

On-Call Commercial Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Services (Citywide) - The City of San Antonio solicited proposals from qualified contractors interested in providing commercial heating ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) maintenance and repairs through an on-call contracting services (OCCS) contract, also referred to as a job order contract (JOC). Services shall be for HVAC maintenance and repairs for City facilities throughout the City of San Antonio. Trade services within new building construction, remodeling or alterations of an existing building will not be included.

Solicitation Type: Request for Competitive Sealed Proposal

Contract Value: \$3.5 Million (estimated at \$350,000 per contract year per contractor)

Term of Contract: 2 years with 3, 1-year renewal options
