The following high-profile project has completed the solicitation process. This item is presented to the Audit and Accountability Committee for review prior to the full City Council for consideration.

On-Call Structural Engineering Services - Public Works Department issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for on-call structural engineering services for firms to provide on-call or as needed professional structural engineering services related to departmental and citywide construction projects. The scope of work for these services may include, but are not limited to pre-design services, design services, construction phase services, project close-out and warranty follow-up services. The types of services may include assessment and evaluation of structural systems, design services for the project utilizing all information from the project schematic, perform necessary site visits and inspections to confirm the amount and quality of work, confirm compliance with contract documents for project close-out, inspect and verify delivery of all warranty information.

No material findings were noted that would prevent the City from awarding to the selected vendors.

Staff recommends committee approval to proceed with scheduling this item for full City Council consideration.
