The respondent's program should include the following, but is not limited to, maintaining a sufficient inventory of specified uniform and accessory items; receive, process, and ship individual orders; perform apparel alterations and repairs; provide embroidery, screen printing, and heat pressing services and maintain computerized transaction records by individual customer to include credit balance through a web-based system.
