Briefing on the Vision Zero program and status update on projects currently in design and under construction.

**SUMMARY:**

A briefing on Vision Zero Projects.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

In 2016, the City of San Antonio adopted the Vision Zero safety strategy to eliminate all traffic fatalities and serious injuries through the creation of an Action Plan. Since 2017, \$1,000,000 has been allocated annually to provide: 1.) Education & Outreach programs to the public; 2.) Severe Injury Reports on crash data and safety trends associated with auto, pedestrian and bicycle injuries and fatalities; and 3.) Safety measures such as mid-block crossings and pavement markings to increase vulnerable road user safety.

In 2022, the Transportation Department was provided with an additional \$5.2 million through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for implementation of safety improvements with the focus on mid-block crossings. Various projects to address safety concerns across the City are currently in design and construction. The department leverages state and federal grant funds to maximize available funding and collaborates with the Texas Department of Transportation and other City Departments including the Public Works Department to implement identified projects.
