ADDR-SNC-23-12700004 Street Name Change of AT&T Center Parkway to Frost Bank Center Drive.

SUMMARY:

A request by Mike Garza on behalf of the San Antonio Spurs L.L.C. for approval of a resolution to rename AT&T Center Parkway, located between East Houston Street and IH-35, as Frost Bank Center Drive.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The street name change request is being submitted by Mike Garza on behalf of the San Antonio Spurs L.L.C.

This street name change would require twenty-one (21) address changes.

The segment consists of approximately six thousand, six hundred and eighty (6,680) linear feet, ten (10) TxDot Right of Way signs, two (2) ground mounted signs and fourteen (14) streetlight mounted signs.
