## Request

A request for a 2' special exception from the 6' maximum fence height, as described in Section $35-514$, to allow an $8^{\prime}$ solid screen fence along the side and rear property lines.

## Executive Summary

The subject property is located along Prinz Drive near Spanish Oaks. The subject property currently has a single-family residence constructed on the property and is zoned residential single family. The applicant has already installed an 8 foot solid screen privacy fence along the side property line and is proposing to build an 8 foot solid screen privacy fence along the rear property line.

## Code Enforcement History

June 2021 - New fence built without a permit.

## Zoning History

The subject property was annexed by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance 18115, dated September 24, 1952 and was zoned "A" Single-Family Residence District. Upon adoption of the 2001 Unified Development Code, the zoning converted from "A" to the current "R-5" residential Single-Family District, established by Ordinance 93881, dated May 3, 2001.

## Comprehensive Plan Consistency/Neighborhood Association

The subject property is in the San Antonio International Airport Vicinity Area Plan and is designated "Low Density Residential" in the future land use component of the plan. The subject property is located within the Greater Harmony Hills Neighborhood Association and were notified of the case.

## Street Classification

Prinz Street is classified as a local road.

## Criteria for Review - Special Exception for Side and Rear Fence Height

According to Section $35-482(\mathrm{~h})$ of the UDC, in order for a special exception to be granted, the Board of Adjustment must find that the request meets each of the five following conditions:
A. The special exception will be in harmony with the spirit and purpose of the chapter.

The UDC states the Board of Adjustment can grant a special exception for a fence height modification. The additional fence height was observed upon the site visit and, if granted, staff finds the request would be in harmony with the spirit and purpose of the ordinance. There is also some slight topographical changes in the area allowing the additional fence height to observe the spirit and purpose of the chapter.
B. The public welfare and convenience will be substantially served.

In this case, these criteria are represented by fence heights to protect residential property owners while still promoting a sense of community. An $8^{\prime}$ tall fence along the side and rear yard does not pose any adverse effects to the public welfare.
C. The neighboring property will not be substantially injured by such proposed use.

The fence will create enhanced security and privacy for the subject property and is unlikely to substantially injure any neighboring properties.
D. The special exception will not alter the essential character of the district and location in which the property for which the special exception is sought.

The additional height for the side and rear yard fencing will not alter the essential character of the district.
E. The special exception will not weaken the general purpose of the district or the regulations herein established for the specific district.

The current zoning permits the current use of a single-family home. The requested special exception will not weaken the general purpose of the district.

## Alternative to Applicant's Request

The alternative to the applicant's request is to conform to the Fence Height Regulations of Section 35-514.

## Staff Recommendation - Side and Rear Yard Fence Special Exception

Staff recommends Approval in BOA-21-10300121 based on the following findings of fact:

1. The additional two feet in height does not pose any danger to the public and will not negatively affect property values; and
2. The additional two feet in height will provide additional safety and security to the property; and
3. The eight foot fence will provide additional privacy for the swimming pool in the rear of property.
