SAWS proposed sewage infrastructure options for Guajolote Ranch development project

SUMMARY:

A briefing on the Guajolote Ranch development project and associated sewage infrastructure options to be presented to the SAWS Board of Directors for consideration.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The developer of Guajolote Ranch, a 1,160-acre residential development located in northwest Bexar County near Grey Forest, is seeking SAWS water service for the planned 2,000 unit subdivision and proposes to install an onsite waste treatment facility. City staff will provide an overview of available sewer infrastructure options currently being evaluated by SAWS and will outline any potential impacts to adjacent properties protected by conservation easements purchased by the Edwards Aquifer Protection Program.
