Pre-Solicitation High Profile Item for Annual Contract for Tree Planting and Care Services

SUMMARY:

The City of San Antonio's Parks & Recreation Department is soliciting proposals from qualified vendors to supply and install trees along streets and various parks and for the maintenance and upkeep of these trees. Services include tree planting, watering, staking, mulching, and correcting or replacing defective, dead, or dying trees under warranty. Contract will be leveraged to plant trees on private property as part of the City's promotional tree giveaways, at public property including rights of way, and in park settings. Scope of services will include the warranty and general upkeep and maintenance of planted trees. As a part of this contract, a variable and comprehensive species list will be developed to focus on species diversification.
