BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On July 10, 2021, in partnership with Bexar County and the San Antonio River Authority (SARA), the City submitted a RAISE grant application for \$25 million to the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) for completion of the 7.1-mile Zarzamora Creek segment of the Howard W. Peak Greenway Trail. This segment would connect the VIA Ingram Road Transit Center and the SARA Westside Creeks Restoration project.

The City received a “Recommended” rating from the USDOT but not “Highly Recommended”.
