SUBJECT:

Community Spay and Neuter Contract Amendments

SUMMARY:

This Ordinance authorizes an amendment to three community spay and neuter contracts in the amount of \$315,000.00 to provide 2,500 additional spay/neuter surgeries from 5,555 to 8,055 surgeries for FY 2024. The amendments for each agreement are as follows:

1. Amends the agreement with Spay Neuter Inject Protect San Antonio (SNIPSA) to increase funding from \$249,750.00 to an amount not to exceed \$339,750.00 for 700 additional surgeries;
2. Amends the agreement with Spay Neuter Assistance Program, Inc. (SNAP) to increase funding from \$145,000.00 to an amount not to exceed \$270,000.00 for 1,000 additional surgeries;
3. Amends the agreement with Spay Neuter Network (SNN) to increase funding from \$351,675.00 to an amount not to exceed \$451,675.00 for 800 additional surgeries;

Funding is available in the FY 2024 Adopted General Fund Budget. Funding for subsequent years is available contingent upon City Council approval of the annual budget.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Since FY 2012, ACS has partnered with local community providers to spay and neuter animals as part of the Community Spay/Neuter Program. This program is specifically designed for pet owners in targeted San Antonio zip codes.

In September 2022, Council approved an ordinance authorizing an agreement with Spay-Neuter-Inject-Project (SNIPSA) for community spay and neuter services for a three-year term with two one-year options to renew and an annual contract amount not to exceed \$249,750 to provide 1,850 surgeries. Through April of 2024, SNIPSA has completed 1,805 surgeries under this contract and has the ability to exceed their initial surgery target. The proposed amendment would increase the FY 2024 contract amount from \$249,750 to \$349,750 and their surgery target from 1,850 to 2,550.

In May 2023, Council approved an ordinance authorizing an agreement with Spay Neuter Assistance Program, Inc. (SNAP) for community spay and neuter services for a three-year term with two one-year options to renew. The agreement includes a contract amount not to exceed \$145,000 in Year One (June 2023 – September 2024), and an annual contract amount of \$70,000 in subsequent years. For Year One, \$75,000 was dedicated to 600 feral cat surgeries and \$70,000 was dedicated for 500 targeted zip code surgeries. As of February 2024, SNAP has exhausted their funding for this agreement but continues to have the capacity to perform surgeries. The proposed amendment would increase the Year One contract amount from \$145,000 to \$270,000 and increase the surgery target to 2,100.

In May 2023, Council also approved an agreement with Spay Neuter Network (SNN) for community spay and neuter services for a three-year term with two, one-year renewal options. The agreement included an initial annual contract amount not to exceed \$280,000 and a surgery target of 2,000. The agreement was amended to increase the annual contract amount to \$351,675 and the surgery target to 2,605. Through March 2024, SNN has performed 1,504 surgeries under this agreement and has the ability to exceed their amended surgery target. The proposed amendment would increase the FY 2024 contract amount from \$351,675 to \$451,675 and increase the surgery target to 3,405.

ISSUE:

This Ordinance authorizes an amendment to three community spay and neuter contracts with Spay Neuter Inject Protect San Antonio (SNIPSA), Spay Neuter Assistance Program, Inc. (SNAP), and Spay Neuter Network (SNN) an additional 2,500 more spay/neuter surgeries with a total contract value increase of \$315,000.00 from \$746,425.00 to \$1,061,425.00.

ALTERNATIVES:

Should the City Council not approve amending the three community spay and neuter contracts, approximately 2,500 fewer free surgeries in FY 2024 would be offered to residents and their animals.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This ordinance authorizing amendments to three community spay and neuter contracts with Spay Neuter Inject Protect San Antonio (SNIPSA), Spay Neuter Assistance Program Inc. (SNAP), and Spay Neuter Network (SNN) for 2,500 more spay/neuter surgeries from 5,555 to 8,055 surgeries for an amount not to exceed \$315,000.00 from \$746,425.00 to \$1,061,425.00 for FY 2024. Funding is available in the FY 2024 Adopted General Fund Budget.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

FIRST AMENDMENT OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR SPAY-NEUTER SURGICAL SERVICES

This First Amendment of the Professional Services Agreement is entered into by and between the City of San Antonio (“City”), acting by and through the Director of the San Antonio Animal Care Services Department or designee, and Spay Neuter Assistance Program, Inc. (“SNAP”), acting by and through its Executive Director, Dr. Karen Olguin, DVM, and is as follows:

WHEREAS, through Ordinance No. 2023-05-18-0330, passed and approved on 18th day of May, 2023, City Council authorized the execution of an Agreement (“Agreement”) with Contractor for the provision of spay and neuter services by Contractor for pet owners in targeted areas; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to amend the Agreement to increase the annual funding for this agreement for Fiscal Year 2024; **NOW THEREFORE:**

I. Amendment

Section 4.1 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.1 In consideration of Contractor's performance in a satisfactory and efficient manner, as determined solely by Director, of all services and activities set forth in this Agreement, City agrees to pay Contractor an amount not to exceed \$410,000.00 as total compensation, to be paid to Contractor as follows:

4.1.1 In Year 1 of the Agreement (June 2023 – September 2024), City agrees to be pay Contractor an amount not to exceed \$270,000.00 for approximately 1,725 spay and neuter surgeries.

4.1.1.1 Feral cat surgeries shall be reimbursed per the following rates:

Section 16 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any alteration, addition or deletion to the terms hereof shall be by amendment in writing executed by both City and Contractor and evidenced by passage of a subsequent City ordinance, as to City's approval; provided, however, during the term of the Agreement and subject to funding availability, the Director of the Animal Care Services Department shall have the authority to execute an amendment of this Agreement without further action by the San Antonio City Council, to 1) adjust the amount of funding under this Agreement, 2) adjust the rate per surgery annually and/or (3) modifications to the Scope of Work due to the adjustment described in subsection (A) of this Section or for any other reason, so long as the terms of the amendment are reasonably within the parameters set forth in the original Scope of Work.

II.

All other terms, conditions, covenants and provisions of the Agreement approved through Ordinance No. _____, are hereby in effect, renewed and extended, save and except those terms which the Parties have amended.

SECOND AMENDMENT OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR SPAY-NEUTER SURGICAL SERVICES

This Second Amendment of the Professional Services Agreement is entered into by and between the City of San Antonio (“City”), acting by and through the Director of the San Antonio Animal Care Services Department or designee, and Spay Neuter Network (“Contractor”), acting by and through its Executive Director Jordan Craig, and is as follows:

WHEREAS, through Ordinance No. 2023-05-18-0330, passed and approved on 18th day of May 2023, City Council authorized the execution of an Agreement (“Agreement”) with Contractor for the provision of spay and neuter services by Contractor for pet owners in targeted areas; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to amend the Agreement to increase the annual funding for this agreement; **NOW THEREFORE:**

I. Amendment

Section 3.2 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 3.2 Contractor shall perform up to a total 3,405 spay-neuter surgeries per fiscal year unless otherwise specifically provided for in this agreement. All sterilization surgeries are to be performed for pets of pet owners who reside in targeted areas within the City as determined and approved by the Director of Animal Care Services (ACS). Director may also authorize the utilization of vouchers for residents who may not live in the defined targeted areas.

Section 4.1 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 4.1 In consideration of Contractor's performance in a satisfactory and efficient manner, as determined solely by Director, of all services and activities set forth in this Agreement, City agrees to pay Contractor an amount not to exceed \$1,154,725.00 as total compensation, to be paid to Contractor as follows:

- 4.1.1 In Year 1 of the Agreement (June 2023 – September 2024), City agrees to be pay Contractor an amount not to exceed \$ 451,375.00 for spay neuter surgeries. Spay and neuter surgeries shall be reimbursed per the following rates:

All pre- and post-surgical supplies (such as, but not limited to, cones, medications, etc.) shall be included in the service and reimbursement cost. Any additional services provided to pet owner which are not included in this Agreement shall be paid for by pet owner.

Section 16 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any alteration, addition or deletion to the terms hereof shall be by amendment in writing executed by both City and Contractor and evidenced by passage of a subsequent City ordinance, as to City's approval; provided, however, during the term of the Agreement and subject to funding availability, the Director of the Animal Care Services Department shall have the authority to execute an amendment of this Agreement without further action by the San Antonio City Council, to 1) adjust the amount of funding under this Agreement, 2) adjust the rate per surgery annually and/or (3) modifications to the Scope of Work due to the adjustment described in subsection (A) of this Section or for any other reason, so long as the terms of the amendment are reasonably within the parameters set forth in the original Scope of Work.

II.

All other terms, conditions, covenants and provisions of the Agreement approved through Ordinance No. 2022-09-15-0674, are hereby in effect, renewed and extended, save and except those terms which the Parties have amended.

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AMENDMENTS TO THREE COMMUNITY SPAY AND NEUTER CONTRACTS WITH SPAY NEUTER INJECT PROTECT SAN ANTONIO (SNIPSA), SPAY NEUTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, INC. (SNAP), AND SPAY NEUTER NETWORK (SNN) FOR 2,500 MORE SPAY/NEUTER SURGERIES FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$315,000.00 FOR FY 2024. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE IN THE FY 2024 ADOPTED GENERAL FUND BUDGET. FUNDING FOR SUBSEQUENT YEARS IS AVAILABLE CONTINGENT UPON CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL OF THE ANNUAL BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment would increase the FY 2024 contract amount from \$351,675 to \$451,675 and increase the surgery target to 3,405;

WHEREAS, these amendments will also give Animal Care Services the ability to amend the Agreements to adjust funding and rates for future fiscal years for the purpose of increasing the number of spay and neuter surgeries; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee or the Director of the Animal Care Services or designee is authorized to execute the amendments to three community spay and neuter contracts with Spay Neuter Inject Protect San Antonio (SNIPSA), Spay Neuter Assistance Program, Inc. (SNAP), and Spay Neuter Network (SNN) for 2,500 more spay/neuter surgeries for an amount not to exceed \$315,000.00 for FY 2024. Funding is available in the FY 2024 Adopted General Fund Budget. Funding for subsequent years is available contingent upon City Council approval of the annual budget. Copies of the amendments in substantially final form are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I - III**.

SECTION 2. Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to the various vendors assigned within this ordinance for an estimated annual cost of \$315,000.00. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2024 budget and subsequent budgets for the duration of this contract approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

FIFTH AMENDMENT OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR SPAY-NEUTER SURGICAL SERVICES

This Fifth Amendment of the Professional Services Agreement is entered into by and between the City of San Antonio (“City”), acting by and through the Director of the San Antonio Animal Care Services Department or designee, and Spay-Neuter-Inject-Project San Antonio, d/b/a SNIPSA (“Contractor”), acting by and through its Executive Director, Shannon Espy, DVM, and is as follows:

WHEREAS, through Ordinance No. 2022-09-15-0674, passed and approved on 15th day of September 2022, City Council authorized the execution of an Agreement (“Agreement”) with Contractor for the provision of spay and neuter services by Contractor for pet owners in targeted areas; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed the Second Amendment on June 5, 2023, to increase the reimbursement amounts for the community spay-neuter surgeries to conform with the FY24 spay-neuter service agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed the Third Amendment September 2023 to increase the funding for fiscal year 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed the Fourth Amendment September 2023 to increase the funding for fiscal year 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to amend the Agreement to increase funding for fiscal year 2024; **NOW THEREFORE:**

I. Amendment

Section 3.2 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 3.2 Contractor shall perform up to a total of 2,550 spay-neuter surgeries per fiscal year unless otherwise specifically provided for in this agreement. All sterilization surgeries are to be performed for pets of pet owners who reside in targeted areas within the City as determined and approved by the Director of Animal Care Services. Director may also authorize the utilization of vouchers for residents who may not live in the defined targeted areas.

Section 4.1 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 4.1 In consideration of Contractor's performance in a satisfactory and efficient manner, as determined solely by Director, of all services and activities set forth in this Agreement, City agrees to pay Contractor an amount not to exceed \$789,500.00 as total compensation, to be paid to Contractor as follows:

4.1.1 City agrees to pay Contractor a total compensation amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 for Fiscal Year 2023 (October 1, 2022 – September 30, 2023). City agrees to pay Contractor a total compensation amount not to exceed \$339,750.00 for Fiscal Year 2024 (October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024) and a total compensation amount not to exceed \$249,750.00 for Fiscal Year 2025 (October 1, 2024 – September 30, 2025) for spay and neuter surgeries. Spay and neuter surgeries shall be reimbursed per the following rates:

II.

All other terms, conditions, covenants and provisions of the Agreement approved through Ordinance No. 2022-09-15-0674, are hereby in effect, renewed and extended, save and except those terms which the Parties have amended.

Background



ACS relies on community partners to provide over 13,000 free spay/neuter surgeries per year for San Antonio pets



ACS partners with 5 spay/neuter providers to offer free surgeries for pet owners in targeted zip codes



Community Spay/Neuter contracts increase accessibility to spay/neuter and other vet services



Partners are reimbursed for each surgery through a tiered fee schedule based on weight and sex, between \$86 and \$147 per surgery

Amendments



- SNIPSA
 - Increase funding by \$90,000, from \$249,750 to \$339,750
 - Increase surgery target by 700, from 1,850 to 2,250
- SNAP
 - Increase funding by \$125,000, from \$145,000 to \$270,000
 - Increase surgery target by 1,000, from 1,100 to 2,100
- Spay Neuter Network
 - Increase funding by \$100,000, from \$351,675 to \$451,675
 - Increase surgery target by 800, from 2,605 to 3,405
