SUMMARY:

Ordinance Canvassing the June 7, 2025 Runoff Election

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On February 9, 2025, the City Council ordered a General Election and possible Runoff Election, if needed, for the purpose of electing ten members of the City Council, Place 1 through 10, and one member to be elected as Mayor, Place 11. On Saturday, May 3, 2025, the City of San Antonio held a General Election which was canvassed on May 14, 2025.

The City Charter requires candidates to win their respective place by a majority vote of qualified electors voting in that district. In accordance with the election order, a Runoff Election for Mayor and City Council Place 1, 6, 8, and 9 was held on June 7, 2025. Early voting for the Runoff Election occurred from Tuesday, May 27, through Tuesday, June 3, 2025. Polling locations and hours were established and publicly posted in compliance with legal requirements. The ballot order for candidates in the Runoff Election were the same as on the General Election ballot as required by

Section 52.094(a) of the Texas Election Code.

ISSUE:

The City Council, as the canvassing authority, must canvass the unofficial election results of the Saturday, June 7, 2025 Runoff Election for the Mayoral and City Council Place 1, 6, 8, and 9.

ALTERNATIVES:

There are no alternatives as the City Council is required by law to canvass the Runoff Election results.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the canvassing of the Runoff Election results.

ORDINANCE

CANVASSING THE JUNE 7, 2025 RUNOFF ELECTION RESULTS

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WHEREAS, the general election was held on Saturday, May 3, 2025, to determine the Mayor and Council Members of the City of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, the names of the candidates were submitted to the voters, the election was held and conducted, and the returns were made, as required by the City Charter and the laws of the State of Texas, and declared the official results of the canvass; and

WHEREAS, in the election, no candidate for City Council Districts 1, 6, 8, 9, or Place 11 (Mayor) received a majority of votes for the office sought, and therefore no candidate was elected for these places; and

WHEREAS, the runoff election for those offices was held Saturday, June 7, 2025, and it is necessary to declare the results; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council convened on this the 18th day of June 2025, to canvass the returns of the runoff election held June 7, 2025, and after canvassing the returns of this election, officially finds and determines that this election was duly ordered; proper notice of this election was given; proper election officers were duly appointed prior to this election; the election was duly held; the City has complied with the Federal Voting Rights Act, the Texas Election Code, and the City Charter; and due returns of the result of this election have been made and delivered, all in accordance with the law and the Ordinance calling the election.

SECTION 2. The City Council does officially find and declare the results of the runoff election to be as follows:
