Approval of Minutes

1. Approval of the minutes from the Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission meeting on October 17, 2022

2. Notice and appropriate action regarding the approval of the eligibility list for the position of Firefighter Trainee created from Firefighter Trainee Examination administered on May 5, 2022. This eligibility list will be valid for a period of one (1) year from the effective date or until the list is exhausted.
3. Notice and appropriate action regarding the approval to administer a District Fire Chief Assessment Center to the top 20 passing participants of the District Fire Chief written examination. This eligibility list will be valid for 18 months from the date of certification by the Commission.
