AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN, A COMPONENT OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO MASTER PLAN, BY REALIGNING A PROPOSED SEGMENT OF BECK ROAD, A SECONDARY ARTERIAL TYPE A REQUIRING 86' FEET OF RIGHT-OF-WAY, BETWEEN APPROXIMATELY 0.9 MILES SOUTH OF EXISTING NEW SULPHUR SPRINGS ROAD AND EXISTING BURSHARD ROAD.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio Major Thoroughfare Plan was adopted on September 21, 1978 by City Council as a component of the City of San Antonio Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on March 24, 2021 by the Planning Commission allowing all interested citizens to be heard: **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1: The Major Thoroughfare Plan, a component of the Master Plan of the City, is amended to:

1. Realign a proposed segment of Beck Road, a Secondary Arterial Type A requiring 86' feet of right-of-way, between approximately 0.9 miles south of existing New Sulphur Springs Road and existing Burshard Road.

The Amendment is more particularly described in **Attachment "A,"** attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective _____ 2024.
