Background


- In May 2017, voters approved \$2.0 Million for pedestrian improvements to the Wurzbach Corridor (Fredericksburg Road to IH-10).
- Project will improve pedestrian access along Wurzbach Road Corridor (Fredericksburg Road to IH-10) to meet current ADA standards and UDC guidelines.




Scope of Work

Recommendation

Approval of a construction contract to Keeley Construction Group, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$1,726, 447.94 of which \$31,380.28 will be reimbursed by SAWS and \$14,023.28 will be reimbursed by CPS Energy for necessary adjustments to their existing infrastructure related to the construction of Wurzbach Corridor Sidewalks Project.
