Passenger Facility Charges (PFC)

Project Criteria

- Airports use collected PFC funds for capital projects supporting certain criteria:
 - enhance safety, security and capacity; reduce noise; & increase air carrier competition

Projects

- Range from funding an extension of Runway 31 & Taxiway R to construction of Terminal B (and supporting projects) & rehabilitation of Terminal A to purchase of new Aircraft Firefighting and Rescue Vehicles and noise monitoring equipment
- All previously approved projects have been completed.

Funding Collected

- The City is approved to collect and use \$431,280,175 in PFC Funds

Proposed Action

This action supports & approves the submission of a PFC application to the Federal Aviation Administration to allow the Terminal A Ground Load Facility Project to use PFC funds at San Antonio International Airport, including the current \$32,644,920 available in the PFC Fund for design and construction costs

This application will also continue the PFC collection when the current applications expire on February 28, 2029.
