**SUBJECT:**

Resolution authorizing additional funding up to \$100,000 to complete a comprehensive traffic and parking study for Brackenridge Park.

**SUMMARY:**

Resolution authorizing additional funding up to \$100,000 to complete a comprehensive traffic and parking study for Brackenridge Park.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

In December 2022, the Midtown TIRZ approved funding up to \$100,000 for a phase 1 traffic study for Brackenridge Park. This was intended to support the data collection portions of a future comprehensive traffic and parking study for the park. The study is set to begin following the completion of the Brackenridge Park Reconciled Plan work.

**ISSUE:**

The proposed comprehensive traffic and parking study will include the previously identified data collection and provide a study for vehicle traffic, bicycle and pedestrian traffic, and parking in and around Brackenridge Park and surrounding neighborhoods.

COSA is able to execute the study through existing on-call contracts with Pape Dawson Engineers. The project is expected to take approximately 16 weeks to complete.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

There is no fiscal impact to the City of San Antonio. The increment is taken from the Midtown TIRZ.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

If the additional funding is not approved, the City will proceed with only Phase I of the study which includes data collection but not comprehensive analysis of traffic and parking around Brackenridge Park.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the Midtown TIRZ authorize additional funding up to \$100,000 to complete a comprehensive traffic and parking study for Brackenridge Park.
