High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Grant Program

- Grant Period: January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2025
- Total Budget: \$2,181,533.00
- Ordinance authorizes submission and acceptance up to \$2,181,533.00 from ONDCP Agency plus additional grant award modifications up to 20%.

 - HIDTA 2021- Initial budget of \$2,173,086.

- **Mission:** to reduce drug trafficking in the San Antonio metropolitan area by instituting innovative narcotic enforcement investigations and seizing illegally obtained assets in an effort to reduce the profitability of narcotics trafficking.
