SUBJECT:

Purchase of BMW Motorcycles for SAPD

SUMMARY:

This ordinance authorizes a contract with Jimenez Motorsports, LLC. to provide the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) with seven BMW R 1250 RT-P motorcycles for a total cost of \$220,150.00. Funding in the amount of \$220,150.00 is available from the Equipment Renewal and Replacement Fund FY 2024 Adopted Budget.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Submitted for City Council consideration and action is an offer submitted by Jimenez Motorsports, LLC. to provide SAPD with seven replacement BMW R 1250 RT-P motorcycles for a total cost of \$220,150.00 for SAPD, Traffic Control Motor Unit.

The City issued a Request for Offer (RFO) for “Purchase of BMW Motorcycles for San Antonio Police Department (SAPD)” (RFO 6100017809) on February 16, 2024 with a submission deadline of March 8, 2024. The RFO was advertised in the HartBeat, TVSA channel, the City’s Bidding & Contracting Opportunities website, the San Antonio e-Procurement System and an email notification was released to a list of potential Respondents. One proposal was received. Jimenez

Motorsports, LLC. is recommended for contract award based on the City's published bid specifications and requirements.

This purchase was made utilizing a competitive sole brand, public health or safety exemption to allow SAPD to procure brand specific motorcycles to replace existing patrol motorcycles that have reached their useful life expectancy. The SAPD Labor Relations Committee (LRC) concurs with SAPD staff findings and memorialized the decision on LRC agenda memo #22-08.

The motorcycles to be supplied under this contract are replacing existing patrol motorcycles that have reached their useful life expectancy. These motorcycles will be utilized by SAPD to meet established goals for law enforcement services within the City.

This contract will begin upon the effective date of the ordinance awarding the contract will terminate upon completion of all work or delivery of all goods ordered, as applicable.

ISSUE:

This contract will provide seven replacement BMW R1250 RT-P Motorcycles for the SAPD, Traffic Patrol Unit. Delivery is anticipated 180 days from the date a purchase order is issued.

The BMW Motorcycles are covered by a minimum 36 month/60,000-mile warranty that will start on the day each unit is placed in service. The life expectancy of these motorcycles is typically 36 months when repair costs are no longer economical to retain.

This contract will provide Class 1 vehicles. Light-duty vehicles are defined as Class 1 - Class 2 vehicles weighing 10,000 lbs. 'or less. Medium-duty vehicles are defined as Class 3 - Class 6 vehicles weighing 10,001 - 26,000 lbs. Heavy-duty vehicles are defined as Class 7 - Class 8 vehicles weighing 26,001 and greater. A commercial driver license is required to operate heavy-duty vehicles.

The Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Ordinance requirements were waived due to the lack of small, minority, and/or women businesses available to provide these goods and services.

This contract is an exception to the Local Preference Program.

The Veteran—Owned Business Preference Program does not apply to commodities non-professional service contract, so no preference was applied to this contract.

ALTERNATIVES:

Should this contract not be approved, SAPD will be required to repair and maintain existing motorcycles. Delaying this acquisition could result in higher operational expenses and could impact fleet availability due to repairs of existing motorcycles. The production cutoff date for new orders is August 1, 2024; City may need to wait for model year 2025 if these motorcycles are not ordered by August 2024.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This ordinance authorizes a contract with Jimenez Motorsports, LLC. to provide the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) with seven BMW R 1250 RT-P motorcycles for a total cost of \$220,150.00. Funding in the amount of \$220,150.00 is available from the Equipment Renewal and Replacement Fund FY 2024 Adopted Budget.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of this contract with Jimenez Motorsports, LLC. for the purchase of seven (7) replacement BMW R 1250 RT-P motorcycles for a total cost of \$220,150.00 for SAPD.

This contract was procured by means of a competitive sole brand, public health or safety exemption and a Contract Disclosure Form is not required.
