





# FY23 Metro Health – Division Highlights



## Community Health & Safety



880 children enrolled in Early Head Start received tooth decay prevention services.

## Communicable Disease



Epidemiology Program conducted 90,710 infectious disease investigations.

## Environmental Health & Operations



Environmental Health Officers completed 370,066 food establishment, community pool, mobile vendor and temporary event inspections.



# FY23 SA Forward Highlights



## Access to Care

175 medical providers at clinician workshops stated their intention to implement strategies to improve access to care.



## Data & Technology Infrastructure

Metro Health successfully secured an Infectious Disease Forecasting and Modeling System Grant.



## Food Insecurity & Nutrition

40 Healthy Corner Stores purchased a combined 72,000 pounds of fruits and vegetables.

## Health Equity & Social Justice



Office of Policy & Civic Engagement developed a food insecurity dashboard for Bexar County.
