

SAWS Past Due Receivables Growth










CPSE Residential vs Commercial Customers Subject to Disconnect



SAWS Residential vs Commercial Customers Subject to Disconnect




CPSE Affordability* vs Non-Affordability Customers Disconnect Eligible





SAWS Affordability* vs Non-Affordability Customers Disconnect Eligible



Reporting Requirements




Utility becomes subrecipient and must comply with reporting requirements; COSA must monitor subrecipient

Requires evidence-based intervention or rigorous program evaluation to promote equitable outcomes

Describe equity goals to serve marginalized community, describe how applicants made aware, differences in levels of access, describe outcomes, and indicate if it closes equity gaps, and report progress by race, ethnicity other dimensions annually.

Required to be included in Project Inventory Report
