I. Call to Order

III. Approval of Meeting Minutes

IV. Individual Items for Consideration

Update on 2022 Bond Program:



The Technical & Community Advisory Committee has been working on a letter in support of a climate and sustainability checklist during the design phase of the 2022 Bond, and adoption of checklist and prioritization earlier in the process for future Bonds. Once the letter is finalized, the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Technical & Community Advisory Committee will send to all City Council representatives and their staff for consideration. The checklist for future bonds will be developed with input from both Advisory Committees.

Update on Unified Development Code (UDC):

Melnick updated the Advisory Committee members on the UDC amendment process, including the feedback that the Office of Sustainability will be submitting on behalf of the Advisory Committees. The following amendment recommendations will be submitted:

- Introductory Language/ Consistency – Addition of SA Climate Ready introductory Language/ Consistency with Sa Climate Ready
- Parking – Permeable material and/or green infrastructure and energy efficient lighting for parking lots
- Transportation & Street Design – Use of alternative building materials to increase reflectivity, low-carbon materials, dark sky compliant light fixtures, and an increased use of permeable pavement
- Dark Sky (MLOD) – Parking lot light fixtures and streetlights compliant with dark sky practices
- Tree Preservation – Focusing canopy increase on areas with high-combined equity scores or with significant Urban Heat Island, as well as increase selection of tree species that are resilient to climate change.

The Office of Sustainability will continue to notify the Advisory Committees on the status of the amendment recommendations and will prepare amendment suggestions for the upcoming Buildings & Energy Code update process.

Climate Equity Tool Worksession:

Advisory Committee members reviewed the most recent draft of the Climate Equity Tool and worked together to analyze a hypothetical initiative, EV readiness. Actionable feedback included clarification on step 1, making key questions more straightforward and providing examples for disaggregated data, and rewording step 2, change who is accountable to who collects the data and include a question regarding who will be most affected. A follow up meeting with the Climate Equity Tool Subcommittee will be scheduled before the next Advisory Committee Meeting.

V. Determination of Next Meeting Date

The next SA Climate Ready Climate Equity Advisory Committee meeting will be held jointly with the SA Climate Ready Technical & Community Advisory Committee, this meeting is scheduled for March 29th, 2022, from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm, and will be virtual.
