| Please provide a brief narrative<br>outlining your reasons for<br>seeking appointment to this<br>board or commission:   | I learned about the Citizen Advisory Action Board (CAAB) and the<br>need for volunteers through an email I received from my City<br>Councilman, John Courage. Like many Americans, I am concerned<br>about media reports of alleged abuse and excessive use of force by<br>members of law enforcement. Fortunately, it does not seem that we have<br>systemic problems of this nature in San Antonio. To the contrary, I am<br>of the impression that our police department has, in general, a good<br>reputation and is well-respected within the community. That said,<br>officers who violate the law and who fail to adhere to departmental<br>procedures should be identified and held accountable for their<br>misconduct. And on the other hand, officers who are wrongly accused<br>should be given an opportunity to clear their names. The CAAB seems<br>an ideal way to achieve both of these goals by providing both the<br>complainant and the accused an opportunity for a full and fair hearing<br>and offer the public at least some opportunity to participate in the<br>review and disciplinary process. From what I have read and been able to<br>discuss with City personnel, it appears that the CAAB is similar in its<br>purpose and function to a grievance committee on which I was<br>appointed to serve by the State Bar of Texas called the Commission for<br>Lawyer Discipline (CFLD). The CFLD adjudicates cases in which a<br>complainant, or the State Bar itself, alleges that a lawyer violated ethical<br>rules or otherwise engaged in misconduct. Following an evidentiary<br>hearing, the CFLD determines whether to assess punishment and, if so,<br>its extent. Although I realize the CAAB's role is strictly advisory in<br>nature, I believe than my eight years serving on the CFLD may be of<br>value. I retired recently from my full-time employment as a Vice<br>President in AT and T's legal department. Although I continue to handle<br>commercial and consumer arbitrations on occasion, I do have the<br>interest, time, and energy to serve on the CAAB and would very much<br>like to do so. Please give my application your favorable consideration. |
