ORDINANCE

APPROVING A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH JP MORGAN CHASE BANK, N.A., AND PAYMENTECH, LLC, FOR MERCHANT BANKING (CREDIT CARD) SERVICES TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT FOR AN ADDITIONAL NINE (9) MONTHS COMMENCING ON JULY 1, 2022, AND ENDING ON MARCH 31, 2023, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR THREE (3) ADDITIONAL MONTHS UNDER THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2012-06-21-0520, passed and approved on June 21, 2021, the City entered into a contract with Paymentech, LLC, for itself and on behalf of JP Morgan Chase Bank, N.A., to provide merchant banking services and related financial services to the City, which commenced on July 1, 2012, and as renewed and extended, expires on June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, in December 2021 the City issued a Request for Proposals for merchant banking services; and

WHEREAS, to ensure the City's ability to continue to accept credit card payments without interruption while the City evaluates the proposals, City Staff has recommended that the Contract be amended to extend the Contract for an additional nine (9) month period, the term of which will commence July 1, 2022, and terminate March 31, 2023, with the option for City to extend for one (1) additional three (3) month term; and

WHEREAS, upon consideration and deliberation of the matter and the City Staff recommendation on it, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to accept the City Staff recommendation; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. This *April 2022 Amendment to Merchant Payment Instrument Processing Contract* ("Extension") between the City and Paymentech, LLC, is hereby approved in all things. A copy of the Extension is attached hereto as **Exhibit I**. The Chief Financial Officer or the Deputy Chief Financial Officer or their designee is hereby authorized to execute the Extension on behalf of the City of San Antonio.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance is available in the included departments' respective operating funds and General Ledger 5202030 as part of the Fiscal Year 2022 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Additional funding is contingent upon City Council approval of the Fiscal Year 2023 and subsequent budgets that fall within the term of the contract.

SECTION 4. Payment is authorized to JP Morgan Chase Bank, N.A., and Paymentech, LLC, and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
